

NUCLEAR SECURITY SUMMIT SEOUL 2012 SECURITY OPERATION CENTER

OVERVIEW

In order to securely and safely complete the Nuclear Security Summit in Seoul 2012, where leaders from 53 countries participated, special force of the National Security and Safety Service had launched its operation in Security Operation Center at COEX. In accordance with all the related organizations cooperation, every single situation had been monitored via INNOWATCH system installed inside the security operation center throughout the Summit.

SCOPE & SOLUTION DELIVERED

- Collect and monitor more than 3,000 surveillance cameras aligned with the VIP movement in Seoul (Seoul Local Police Stations, COEX conference rooms, Gangnam District Office, National Museum of Korea, Hotels, etc)
- PC integration with National Weather Service, Coast Guard Vessels, En-route control system, Ports, Traffic GPS, etc
- TV screen display (YTN, CNN)
- Monitor live cameras from different organizations at central station
- Live cameras integrated on the map of corresponding areas enabling intuitive monitoring
- Display all the cameras using 50" DLP cube (2x4), 40" TV monitor (3x7, 3x4) and 120" Screen

- Prevent security issue beforehand by tracking all the moving paths of leaders
